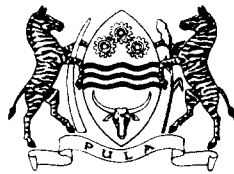


THE BAMANGWATO LAND GRANT (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1970.

AN ACT TO AMEND THE BAMANGWATO LAND GRANT ACT, 1969, BY RECTIFYING ERRORS IN THE SCHEDULE THERETO.

Date of Assent: 3.6.1970

Date of Commencement: 10.6.1970

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana.

Short Title

1. This Act may be cited as the Bamangwato Land Grant (Amendment) Act, 1970.

Amendment of Schedule to Act No. 42 of 1969

2. The Schedule to the Bamangwato Land Grant Act, 1969, is amended —

(a) in the first column of the first annexure by the deletion in items 1, 2 and 3 of the letters "NZ" and the substitution therefor of the letters "NQ"; and

(b) in the first column of the second annexure by the deletion of item 3 and the substitution therefor of —

“3. A strip of land 300 feet wide running from the existing railway near Palapye to the prospective coal mine site at Morupule, together with such land as may be necessary for ancillary branch lines, sidings, stations and other structures required for railway purposes.”
