Date of Assent: 25.11.70.

Date of Commencement: 14.12.1970

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana.

Short Title

1. This Act may be cited as the Commonwealth Countries Act, 1970.

Section 28 of the Constitution to apply to Fiji and Tonga

2. Fiji and Tonga shall be countries to which section 28 of the Constitution applies.
