

THE EMPLOYMENT (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1970

AN ACT TO AMEND THE EMPLOYMENT LAW, 1963, BY RE-DEFINING THE PROPERTY IN LABOUR HEALTH AREAS RESIDENTS WHEREON ARE TO BE PROVIDED BY EMPLOYERS WITH WATER AND MEDICAL AID.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana.

Short Title

1. This Act may be cited as the Employment (Amendment) Act, 1970.

Amendment of Sections 107 and 108 of Law No. 15 of 1963

2. Sections 107 and 108 of the Employment Law, 1963, are amended in subsection (1) thereof by the deletion of "employer's property" and the substitution therefor of "land which the employer is entitled to occupy or of which he makes use."
