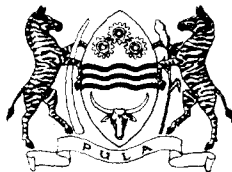

FERENCES TO STATUTORY BODIES BY A FORMER TITLE AFTER SUCH
TITLE HAS BEEN CHANGED OR REPLACED**

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana.

Short Title

1. This Act may be cited as the Interpretation and General Provisions (Amendment) Act, 1970.

Insertion of Section 24B into Law No. 13 of 1966

2. The Interpretation and General Provisions Law, 1966, is amended by the insertion after section 24A of the following section —

"Change in Title of Statutory Body

24B. Whenever the title of any body of persons, corporate or unincorporate, established by any written law is changed or replaced by any other written law, from the date on which such change or replacement takes effect any reference in any law to such body by its former title shall be read and construed as a reference to that body by its changed or replaced title."
