AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAND MEASURE LAW, 1963, SO AS TO PROVIDE FOR THE RECOGNITION OF THE METRE AS A UNIT OF LAND MEASURE AND TO RELATE THE ENGLISH FOOT AND THE CAPE FOOT TO THE METRE

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana.

Short Title

1. This Act may be cited as the Land Measure (Amendment) Act, 1970.

Substitution of Section 2 of Law No. 25 of 1963

2. Section 2 of the Land Measure Law, 1963, is deleted and there is substituted therefor —

“Definition of Units of Land Measure to be recognized

2. The following units of land measure shall be recognized in Botswana, that is to say —

- (a) the metre as defined in the Weights and Measures Act, 1970;
- (b) the English foot, which is equal to 0.304 799 472 metre; and
- (c) the Cape foot, which is equal to 0.314 855 575 metre.”
