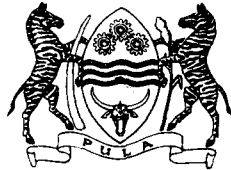

AN ACT TO AMEND THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY (SALARIES AND ALLOWANCES) LAW, 1965

Date of Assent: 25.11.70.

Date of Commencement: 1.1.1971

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana.

Short Title

1. This Act may be cited as the National Assembly (Salaries and Allowances) (Amendment) Act, 1970, and shall come into force on the 1st January, 1971.

Amendment of Section 3 of Law No. 24 of 1965

2. Section 3 of the National Assembly (Salaries and Allowances) Law, 1965, (hereinafter referred to as the principal law) is amended by the deletion of the words "two hundred" appearing therein and by the substitution therefor of the words "five hundred".

Amendment of Schedule to Law No. 24 of 1965

3. Paragraph 1 of the Schedule to the principal law is amended as follows —

- (a) by the deletion of the words “two thousand five hundred” appearing in subparagraph (d) thereof and by the substitution therefor of the words “three thousand”; and
- (b) by the deletion of the words “one thousand” appearing in subparagraph (f) thereof and by the substitution therefor of the words “one thousand five hundred”.
