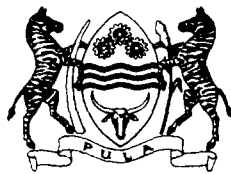


THE PENSIONS, GRATUITIES AND ALLOWANCES (VALIDATION) ACT, 1970.

AN ACT TO VALIDATE CERTAIN AWARDS MADE UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF VARIOUS LAWS RELATING TO PENSIONS.

Date of Assent: 3.6.1970

Date of Commencement: 10.6.1970

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana:

Short Title

1. This Act may be cited as the Pensions Gratuities and Allowances (Validation) Act, 1970.

Pensions etc., deemed to have been granted by Her Majesty's Commissioner.

2. All pensions gratuities and other allowances purporting to be granted by the Financial Secretary or the Deputy Financial Secretary on or between the 8th March, 1965, and the 13th January, 1966, shall be deemed to have been granted by Her Majesty's Commissioner in accordance with the provisions of section 2 of the Pensions Proclamation Chapter 59 of the Laws of the Bechuanaland Protectorate, 1959.

Pensions etc., deemed to have been granted by Minister of Finance

3. All pensions, gratuities and other allowances purporting to be granted by the Financial Secretary or the Deputy Financial Secretary on or between the 14th January, 1966 and the 25th November, 1969, shall be deemed to have been granted by the Minister of Finance in accordance with the provisions of section 3 of the Pensions (Consolidation) Law, 1965.
