AN ACT TO AMEND THE PRECIOUS STONES INDUSTRY (PROTECTION) ACT, 1969 BY ENABLING THE PRESIDENT TO DECLARE AREAS TO BE PRECIOUS STONES PROTECTION AREAS WITH THE CONSENT OF THE HOLDERS OF MINING RIGHTS AND BY MAKING PROVISION FOR FEES FOR PERMITS ISSUED THEREUNDER

Date of Assent: 12.11.1970.

Date of Commencement: 25.11.70.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana.

Short Title

1. This Act may be cited as the Precious Stones Industry (Protection) (Amendment) Act, 1970.

Amendment of section 25 of Act No. 3 of 1969

2. Section 25 of the Precious Stones Industry (Protection) Act, 1969, hereinafter referred to as the principal law, is amended by the insertion immediately after the words "the owner thereof" appearing in subsection (1) thereof of the words "or the holder of any mining right thereover".

Amendment of section 28 of Act No. 3 of 1969

3. Section 28 of the principal law is amended in subsection (1) by the addition of the following paragraph —

"(j) prescribing fees for permits issued under this Act or copies of such permits and prescribing to what persons such fees shall be paid."
