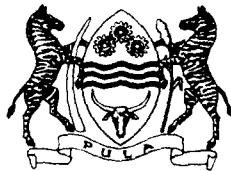


**THE PUBLIC HOLIDAYS (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1970**

**AN ACT TO AMEND THE PUBLIC HOLIDAYS PROCLAMATION (CHAPTER 44)  
BY PRESCRIBING PUBLIC HOLIDAYS APPLICABLE TO THE MINING IN-  
DUSTRY**

Date of Assent: 13.11.1970

Date of Commencement: 25.11.70.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana

**Short Title**

1. This Act may be cited as the Public Holidays (Amendment) Act, 1970.

**Amendment of Section 2 of Chapter 44**

2. Section 2 of the Public Holidays Proclamation is amended by the addition of the following subsection, the present section becoming subsection (1) —

“(2) Notwithstanding anything in subsection (1), only Christmas Day, Good Friday and Botswana Day shall be public holidays in the mining industry, which shall be taken to comprise such undertakings as may be engaged in the winning of minerals as defined in the Mines and Minerals Act, 1967.”

Passed by the National Assembly this day, the 29th October, 1970.
