AN ACT TO AMEND THE PUBLIC SERVICE (SUPPLEMENTARY PROVISIONS) ACT, 1969

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana

Short Title

1. This Act may be cited as the Public Service (Supplementary Provisions) (Amendment) Act, 1970.

Amendment of section 6 of Act No. 47 of 1969

2. Section 6 of the Public Service (Supplementary Provisions) Act, 1969, hereinafter referred to as the principal law, is amended as follows —

- (i) by the deletion of the heading thereto and by the substitution thereof of a new heading as follows — “Influencing a Commission”; and
- (ii) by the insertion immediately after the words “in the course of his duty” appearing therein of the words “or who in the course of his duty improperly”.

Repeal of section 19 of Act No. 47 of 1969

3. Section 19 of the principal law is repealed.

Repeal and replacement of section 21 of Act No. 47 of 1969

4. Section 21 of the principal law is repealed and replaced by a new section as follows —

“Legal representation

21. Any person appearing before a Commission or any person or body conducting an inquiry or investigation on behalf of a Commission shall be entitled to be represented by a legal practitioner admitted to practise in Botswana.”.
