AN ACT TO MAKE FURTHER PROVISION OUT OF THE PUBLIC FUNDS OF BOTSWANA TO MEET CERTAIN EXPENDITURE INCURRED DURING THE YEAR ENDED ON THE 31st MARCH, 1968.

Date of Assent: 14.1.1970.

Date of Commencement: 23.1.1970.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana.

Short Title

1. This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation (1967/68) Act, 1969.

Public Funds Charged with a Further Sum of R691,482

2. The public funds of Botswana are hereby charged with a further sum of R691,482 (six hundred and ninety one thousand four hundred and eighty two rand) to meet expenditure incurred during the financial year ended on the 31st March, 1968, in excess of the amount appropriated for the services of that year, according to the particulars set forth in the Schedule of this Act.
