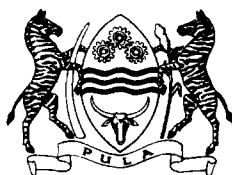


THE SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATION (1968/69) ACT, 1970

AN ACT TO MAKE FURTHER PROVISION OUT OF THE PUBLIC FUNDS OF BOTSWANA TO MEET CERTAIN EXPENDITURE INCURRED DURING THE FINANCIAL YEAR ENDED ON THE 31st MARCH, 1969.

Date of Assent: 3.6.1970

Date of Commencement: 10.6.1970

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana.

Short Title

1. This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation (1968/69) Act, 1970.

Public funds charged with a further sum of R630,985

2. The public funds of Botswana are hereby charged with a further sum of R630,985 (six-hundred and thirty thousand nine hundred and eighty-five rand) to meet expenditure incurred during the Financial Year ended on the 31st March, 1969, in excess of the amount appropriated for the services of that year, according to the particulars set forth in the Schedule to this Act.
