AN ACT TO AMEND THE TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING PROCLAMATION, 1961, BY PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF A DEPUTY CHAIRMAN OF THE TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING BOARD AND BY MAKING CERTAIN CONSEQUENTIAL AMENDMENTS.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana.

Short Title

1. This Act may be cited as the Town and Country Planning (Amendment) Act, 1970.

Amendment of section 4 of Proclamation No. 33 of 1961

2. Section 4 of the Town and Country Planning Proclamation, 1961, is amended —

- (a) in subsection (1) by the insertion after "Chairman" of "and Deputy Chairman",
- (b) in subsection (3) by the insertion after "Chairman" of "or the Deputy Chairman,"; and
- (c) by the deletion of subsection (4) and the substitution of —
“(4) Questions before the Board shall be determined by a majority of votes of members present at a meeting, each member having one vote; in the event of an equality of votes, the Chairman, and in his absence the Deputy Chairman, shall have a casting as well as a deliberative vote.”
