THE INTERPRETATION AND GENERAL PROVISIONS LAW, 1966

THE ABOLITION OF PUBLIC OFFICE (FINANCIAL SECRETARY) ORDER, 1970

Order made by His Excellency the President in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 24A of the Interpretation and General Provisions Law, 1966, and of all other powers thereunto him enabling.

1. This Order may be cited as the Abolition of Public Office (Financial Secretary) Order, 1970.
2. The office of Financial Secretary is abolished with effect from the 3rd day of July, 1970.
3. All functions vested under any law in the Financial Secretary shall, with effect from the date of this Order, vest in the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Finance and Development Planning.
