**TOWNSHIPS PROCLAMATION
(CHAPTER 120)**

DECLARATION OF KASANE TOWNSHIP NOTICE, 1970

(Published on the 21st August, 1970)

In the exercise of the powers vested in him by section 1 of the Townships Proclamation (Chapter 120) His Excellency the President declares Kasane to be a township the limits of which are defined in the Schedule and are shown on Plan RO-13a deposited in the office of the Director of Surveys and Lands.

SCHEDULE

KASANE TOWNSHIP

Commencing at a point on the international boundary between Botswana and the Caprivi Strip (the approximate co-ordinates of which on the provisional Trigonometrical System Lo 25° are Y - 62680 feet and X + 6451760 feet) the boundary runs southwards in a straight line to a point FR 24 on Kasane Forest Reserve Fire Break No. 2; thence generally westwards and southwards along Kasane Fire Break No. 2 to a point FR 19 on the southern side of the road from Kasane to Lesuma; thence westwards along the southern side of the road from Kasane to Lesuma to its intersection with the eastern boundary of Farm No. 1 - RO (being the site of the Chobe River Hotel to be known as Lot 2 Kasane); thence southwards along the eastern boundary of Farm No. 1 - RO to beacon G on diagram DSL No. 1/70 of Lease Area No. 6 - RO; thence continuing southwards to beacon B on diagram DSL No. 1/70; thence westwards in a straight line through beacon A on diagram DSL No. 1/70 to the intersection of the production of line BA with the international boundary between Botswana and the Caprivi Strip; thence generally northwards and eastwards along this international boundary to the point of commencement - as will more fully appear from Plan RO-13a filed in the Department of Surveys and Lands.
