THE STOCK DISEASES PROCLAMATION (CHAPTER 131)

THE DISEASES OF STOCK REGULATIONS

THE DISEASED AREA ORDER, 1970

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by regulation 82A of the Diseases of Stock Regulations and of all other powers thereunto him enabling the Minister of Agriculture makes the following Order.

ORDER

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Diseased Area Order, 1970.

Diseased Area

2. The area of which the boundary is set out in the Schedule to this Order is declared to be a diseased area.

SCHEDULE

Commencing at a point on the international boundary between Botswana and Rhodesia due South of trigonometrical beacon B.P.P. 113, the boundary follows the international boundary generally south-eastwards to the intersection of this international boundary between Botswana and South Africa at the confluence of the Shashe and Limpopo Rivers; thence westwards along this international boundary to a point five miles upstream of the confluence of the Limpopo and Motloutse Rivers; thence westwards along a line parallel to and five miles south of the Motloutse River to the intersection of this line with the main North-South railway line; thence north-westwards in a straight line to a point on the new Francistown-Orapa road thirty miles west of the point where this road crosses the Shashe River; thence northwards in a straight line to the point of commencement.
