THE DISTRICT COUNCILS (BANKING ACCOUNTS) REGULATIONS, 1970

(Published on the 21st August, 1970)

In the exercise of the powers vested in him by section 55 read with section 43 (1) of the Local Government (District Councils) Law, 1965 (No. 35 of 1965), His Excellency the President has been pleased to make the following regulations —

Citation

1. These regulations may be cited as the District Councils (Banking Accounts) Regulations, 1970.

Operation of Banking Account by Council

2. (1) Every account at a Bank opened by a Council in terms of section 43 (1) of the Law shall be opened and maintained in the name of the Council.

(2) The Council shall operate such account by means of instruments signed on its behalf by —

- (a) the District Council Secretary or Treasurer; and
- (b) the Chairman of the Finance Committee or such other person as that Committee may direct.
