**THE EXPORTATION AND IMPORTATION RESTRICTION
PROCLAMATION (CHAPTER 162)**

**THE IMPORT CONTROL (WHOLE MAIZE, MAIZE PRODUCTS AND
MAIZE MEAL) REGULATIONS, 1970**

(Published on the 31st July, 1970)

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 3 of the Exportation and Importation Restriction Proclamation and of all other powers thereunto him enabling His Excellency the President hereby makes the following Regulations.

Citation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Import Control (Whole Maize, Maize Products and Maize Meal) Regulations, 1970.

Restriction on the import of whole maize, maize products and maize meal

2. No person shall import whole maize, maize products or maize meal into Botswana save in accordance with any permission for such importation granted under section 3 of the Proclamation.

Condition

3. It shall be a condition of any permission to import whole maize, maize products or maize meal from South Africa that the importer pays in respect of every 200 lbs of whole maize or maize products a sum of 20 cents or such lesser sum as may be fixed by South Africa as the export levy on whole maize or maize products exported to Botswana and in respect of every 180 lbs of maize meal a sum of 40 cents or such lesser sum as may be fixed by South Africa as the export levy on maize meal exported to Botswana.

Repeal

4. High Commissioner's Notice 175 of 1952 is repealed.
