CONVEYANCERS) (AMENDMENT) (No. 2) RULES, 1970**

In the exercise of the powers vested in me by section 29 of the Legal Practitioners' Act, 1967 (No. 34 of 1967), and of all other powers thereunto me enabling, I, John Richard Dendy Young, Chief Justice of Botswana, with the approval of the Minister of State, hereby make the following Rules—

Citation

1. These Rules may be cited as the Legal Practitioners' (Advocates, Notaries and Conveyancers) (Amendment) (No. 2) Rules, 1970.

Amendment of rule 5 of Statutory Instrument No. 87 of 1969

2. Rule 5(3) of the Legal Practitioners' (Advocates, Notaries and Conveyancers) Rules, 1969 is amended as follows —

- (i) by the deletion of the word "September" appearing therein and by the substitution therefor of the word "June"; and
- (ii) by the deletion of the figures and word "30th June" appearing therein and by the substitution therefor of the figures and word "30th April".
