**THE NATIONAL MUSEUM AND ART GALLERY (FEES)  
REGULATIONS, 1970**

(Published on the 18th September, 1970)

In the exercise of the powers vested in him by section 11 of the National Museum and Art Gallery Act, 1967 (No. 28 of 1967), the Minister of Health, Labour and Home Affairs has made the following regulations —

**Citation**

1. These regulations may be cited as the National Museum and Art Gallery (Fees) Regulations, 1970.

**Fees for use of facilities of Zoological Section of National Museum and Art Gallery**

2. For the use of the facilities for viewing zoological specimens in the Zoological Section of the National Museum and Art Gallery at Gaborone the following fees shall be payable —

By persons under 17 years of age: 1 cent per visit;

By persons over 17 years of age: 3 cents per visit.

**Waiver of Fees**

3. The fees specified in regulation 2 may be waived in the discretion of the Honorary Curator of the National Museum and Art Gallery, being the person whose appointment as such is from time to time notified in the Government Gazette.
