NOTICE OF ADOPTION BY NORTH WEST DISTRICT COUNCIL

(Published on the 28th August, 1970)

In exercise of the powers vested in it by section 36 of the Local Government (District Councils) Law, 1965, the North West District Council has adopted the Control of Boreholes (Model) Bye-Laws, 1968 in whole and without variation as bye-laws of the District Council to be in force within its area of jurisdiction with effect from the date of publication of this Notice.

2. The said bye-laws shall apply to those boreholes listed and numbered in the First Schedule hereto.

3. The fees payable under bye-laws 3, 4 and 7 of the said bye-laws are those specified in the Second Schedule hereto.
