THE PRECIOUS STONES INDUSTRY (PROTECTION) ACT, 1969

THE PRECIOUS STONES INDUSTRY (FORMS) REGULATIONS, 1970

(Published on the 20th March, 1970)

In the exercise of the powers vested in him by section 28 of the Precious Stones Industry (Protection) Act, 1969 (No. 3 of 1969), the Minister of Commerce, Industry and Water Affairs makes the following regulations —

Citation

1. These regulations may be cited as the Precious Stones Industry (Forms) Regulations, 1970.

Form of Declaration of Discovery of Precious Stones

2. The Declaration to be transmitted to the Mining Commissioner in accordance with the provisions of section 3 of the Act by the holder of a prospecting right who has discovered precious stones shall be in the form set out in Schedule 1.

Form of Register

3. The register to be kept by every banker, licensed dealer, producer or accredited agent of a producer in accordance with the provisions of section 16 of the Act shall be in the form set out in Schedule 2.
