

Statutory Instrument No. 60 of 1970

THE RAILWAYS (ADAPTATION OF STATUTORY PROVISIONS) ACT, 1968

(Published on the 31st July, 1970)

Order made by His Excellency the President in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Railways (Adaptation of Statutory Provisions) Act, 1968, and of all other powers thereunto him enabling.

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Railways (Adaptation of Statutory Provisions) Order, 1970.

Repeal of certain provisions of Chapter 163

2. Section 33 of and the Schedule to the Railways Proclamation are repealed.

Agreements

3. In order to give effect in Botswana to new arrangements affecting the administration and operation of the railways, contracts for maintaining an adequate system of public transport of goods and passengers by rail may be entered into on behalf of the Government with the official exercising the functions of General Manager of the organization administering and operating the railways in Botswana.
