THE TRADITIONAL BEER (RETAIL SALES) (MODEL) (AMENDMENT)
BYE-LAWS, 1970**

In the exercise of the powers vested in him by section 36(1) of the Local Government (District Councils) Law, 1965 (No. 35 of 1965), the Minister of Local Government and Lands has caused the following bye-laws to be made —

Citation

1. These bye-laws may be cited as the Traditional Beer (Retail Sales) (Model) (Amendment) Bye-laws, 1970.

Amendment of Bye-law 10 in Statutory Instrument No. 13 of 1970

2. Bye-law 10 of the Traditional Beer (Retail Sales) (Model) Bye-Laws, 1970, is amended by the deletion of —

“Upon the conviction of any licensee of any offence under these bye-laws the District Council may revoke his licence.”

and the substitution of —

“No licensee shall contravene any condition attached to his licence.”
