**THE WATER UTILITIES CORPORATION (VESTING OF ASSETS)
NOTICE, 1970**

(Published on the 31st December, 1970)

In the exercise of the powers vested in him by section 22 of the Water Utilities Corporation Act, 1970 (No. 24 of 1970), the Minister of Commerce, Industry and Water Affairs designates the assets of the Government which are part of, concern or relate to the Government water undertakings as defined in the said Act, and which are set out in the Schedule, as assets which shall from the 1st day of January, 1971, with the consent of the Water Utilities Corporation, vest in the said Corporation.

SCHEDULE

Consumable and other stores, including fuel, spare parts and materials, to the extent to which such stores shall appear in the accounts of the Gaborone Water and Electricity Unit as at the 31st December, 1970, when adopted by the Board of the Gaborone Water and Electricity Project Fund and duly audited, and do not concern or relate to the operation of the electricity undertaking of the Unit.
