NOTICE, 1970**

(Published on the 31st December, 1970)

In the exercise of the powers vested in him by section 4(1)(a) of the Gaborone Water and Electricity Project Fund (Dissolution) Act, 1970, and by section 22 of the Water Utilities Corporation Act, 1970, the Minister of Commerce, Industry and Water Affairs designates the rights of the Government which are part of, concern or relate to the Government water undertakings as defined in the Water Utilities Corporation Act, 1970, and which are set out in the Schedule, as rights which shall from the 1st day of January, 1971, with the consent of the Water Utilities Corporation, vest in the said Corporation.

SCHEDULE

Claims to money owing to the Gaborone Water and Electricity Project Fund and to the Gaborone Water and Electricity Unit for the supply of water or for goods supplied or services rendered to the extent to which the indebtedness giving rise to such claims shall appear in the accounts of the Fund or the Unit as at the 1st January, 1971, when adopted by the Board of Management of the Fund and duly audited, and does not concern, relate to or arise from the operation of the electricity undertaking of the Fund or the Unit.
