AMENDMENT OF SCHEDULES (NO. 31) NOTICE, 1988
(Published on 23th September, 1988)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Finance and Development Planning by sections 50 and 51 of the Customs and Excise Duty Act, the Schedules to the Act are amended to the extent set out in the Schedule below.

SCHEDULE

Part 4 of Schedule No. 1 to the Act

NOTES By the substitution for Notes 7(c) and (d) of the following:

- (c) "imported in such quantities, at such times, for such purposes and subject to such conditions as the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Commerce and Industry, may allow by specific permit after proof has been furnished that these are capital goods or components thereof which are not satisfactorily available locally and are -
- (i) imported by a manufacturer operating at full capacity;
- (ii) for the establishment of a new industry; or
- (iii) required for technology advance,
- (d) cleared in accordance with a permit issued by the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Commerce and Industry, for use in the manufacture, processing, finishing, equipping or packing of goods exclusively for export."
