ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

PARAGRAPH

1. Citation
2. Minimum wage

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Labour and Home Affairs by section 57 of the Apprenticeship and Industrial Training Act, 1983, and acting on the recommendations of the National Advisory Board for Apprenticeship and Industrial Training, the following Order is hereby made —

1. This Order shall be cited as the Apprenticeship Wages Order, 1988. Citation
2. The following shall be the scale of wages which constitute a Minimum
minimum wage payable to persons entering into apprenticeship in any wage
of the designated and apprenticeable traders listed in Schedule 1 of the
Apprenticeship and Industrial Training Regulations, 1987 —

- (a) 1st year of apprenticeship — P125 per month
- (b) 2nd year of apprenticeship — P145 per month
- (c) 3rd year of apprenticeship — P215 per month
- (d) 4th year of apprenticeship — P325 per month
