SCHEDULE

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on His Excellency the President by section 125 of the Botswana Defence Force Act, the following Regulations are hereby made —

Citation	1. These Regulations may be cited as the Botswana Defence Force (Imprisonment and Detention) Regulations, 1988.
Appointment of places of imprisonment	2. Those buildings, enclosures or places or any parts thereof as have been declared by the Minister under section 3 of the Prisons Act, to be prisons shall be places in which persons sentenced to a term of imprisonment under the Botswana Defence Force Act may be required to serve the whole or any part of that sentence.
Authority to sign warrant of committal	3. A warrant of committal signed by the President of a Court Martial shall be sufficient authority for the admission of the person so committed to a place appointed under regulation 2 as a prisoner.
Form of warrant of committal	4. A warrant of committal shall be in the form set out in the Schedule hereto.
Classification and treatment of prisoners	5. The provisions of the Prisons Act relating to the classification and treatment of prisoners shall <i>mutatis mutandis</i> apply to prisoners committed under these Regulations.
