ARRANGEMENT OF REGULATIONS

REGULATION

1. Citation
2. Amendment of Schedule to Cap. 03:06
3. Amendment of Cap. 03:06 Sub.Leg.

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on His Excellency the President by section 4 of the Botswana Honours Act, the following Regulations are hereby made —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Botswana Honours (Amendment) Regulations, 1988. Citation

2. The Schedule to the Botswana Honours Act is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following — Amendment
of

Cap. 03:06

“10. The Botswana Police Distinguished Service Order (D.S.O.) awarded to members of the Botswana Police Force who distinguished themselves by devocation to duty.

11. The Botswana Police Jubilee Service Medal (P.J.S.M.) awarded to a member of the Botswana Police Force who has served a minimum of twenty five years in the Police Force and shown by his conduct and character that he is worth of the honour.

12. The Botswana Police Medal for conspicuous Bravery (C.B.M.) awarded to members of the Botswana Police Force who have, in the course of the service, exhibited conspicuous bravery”.

3. The Botswana Honours Regulations are hereby amended by the renumbering of regulations 11 to 17 as regulation 14 to 20 and the interpolation therein of the following new regulations as regulations 11, 12 and 13 respectively — Amendment

“11. (1) The Botswana Police Distinguished Service Order shall be struck in sterling silver and shall represent a Maltese Cross 4 cm in height.

(2) The obverse side should show the Coat of Arms of Botswana and the inscription ‘Republic of Botswana’.

(3) The reverse side should bear the inscription ‘Botswana Police’ and the legend for Distinguished Service Order, with the name of the recipient and the date of the award of the medal.

(4) The order shall be worn on the left breast pendant from a sterling silver clasp affixed to a plain woven maroon coloured ribbon, 38 mm in width.

12. (1) The Botswana Police Jubilee Service Medal shall be struck in sterling silver and shall be circular in shape with a diameter of 34 mm.

(2) The obverse side should bear the Coat of Arms of Botswana, and the inscription ‘Republic of Botswana’.

(3) The reverse side shall bear the inscription ‘Botswana Police’ and the legend ‘Jubilee Service Medal’ together with the name of the recipient and the date of award of the medal.

(4) The medal shall be worn on the left breast pendant from a sterling silver clasp affixed to a plain woven gold coloured ribbon, 38 mm in width.

(5) The medal shall not be awarded to a Police Officer who has been convicted under the Police Act or any other law involving moral turpitude during the preceding five years.

13. (1) The Botswana Police Medal for conspicuous Bravery shall be struck in sterling silver and be circular in shape with a diameter of 34 mm.

(2) The obverse side shall be the Coat of Arms of Botswana and the inscription 'Republic of Botswana'.

(3) The reverse side shall bear the inscription 'Botswana Police' and the legend 'For Conspicuous Bravery' together with the name of the recipient and the date of award of the medal.

(4) The medal shall be worn on the left breast pendant from a sterling silver clasp affixed to a plain woven ribbon 38 mm in width and consisting of vertical stripes from left to right in the following colours and widths —

Maroon — 19 mm

Gold — 19 mm".
