SCHEDULE

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Director of Veterinary Services by section 4 of the Diseases of Animals Act, the following Order is hereby made —

1. This Order may be cited as the Declaration of Rabies (Veterinary Disease Control Zone 7) (Partial Revocation) Order, 1988. Citation

2. The provisions of the Declaration of Rabies (Veterinary Disease Control Zone 7) Infected Area Order, 1985, shall cease to apply to the areas more fully described in the Schedule hereto. Partial

SCHEDULE

(i) *Tonota Village*

The area within ten kilometre radius of the Kgotla.

(ii) *The whole part of zone 7 North of the River description of the area*

The area lying within the boundaries indicated below.

Boundaries

(a) By the Shashe River to points where it is crossed by the railway line on the West and to the confluence of the Shahe/Ramokgwebana on the East.

(b) *West and North West*

The point where the railway line crosses the Shashe River, following the railway line up to a point where the railway line meets the Botswana/Zimbabwe International boundary.

(c) *East*

From the Shashe/Ramokgwebana Confluence, following the Ramokgwebana river up to the Northern boundary with Zimbabwe.

(iii) *Selebi-Phikwe and Botshabelo area*

The whole of the above areas as officially gazetted.
