ARRANGEMENT OF REGULATIONS

REGULATION

1. Citation
2. Amendment of regulation 3 of S.I. 37 of 1979

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the President by section 3 of the Essential Supplies and Services Act, the following Regulations are hereby made —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Essential Supplies (Speed Limit) (Amendment) Regulations, 1988.

2. Regulation 3 of the Essential Supplies (Speed Limit) Regulations, 1979 (S.I. 37 of 1979) is hereby amended by substituting therefor the following new regulation —

“3. Without prejudice to the Road Traffic (Speed Limits for Specified Vehicles) Regulations —

- (a) no person shall drive or permit to be driven any motor vehicle upon a road at a speed greater than 120km per hour;
- (b) no person shall drive or permit to be driven any motor vehicle through less built-up areas at a speed greater than 80 km per hour;
- (c) no person shall drive or permit to be driven any motor vehicle through cities, towns, villages or built-up areas at a speed greater than 60 km per hour.”
