IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Legal Practitioners Committee by rule 6 of the Legal Practitioners (Examinations and Qualifications for Admission) Rules, 1981, the following syllabus for the examination to be admitted as a notary public is hereby prescribed in terms of section 11 (a) (ii) for a person who has been admitted as an attorney of the Courts of Botswana —

SYLLABUS FOR EXAMINATION

The elementary history of the office of notary public; functions of a notary public with particular reference to the Wills Act, Cap. 31:04; Succession (Rights of Surviving Spouse and Inheritance Family Provisions) Act, Cap. 31:03; Administration of Estates Act, Cap 31:01; Marriage Act, Cap. 29:01; Bills of Exchange Act, Cap. 16:02; Deeds Registry Act, Cap. 33:03; Insolvency Act, Cap. 16:01; Prescriptions Act, Cap. 13:01; Authentication of Documents Act, Cap. 15:02: the preparation of wills, antenuptial contracts, surety bonds, deeds of donations, deeds of separation *a mensa et thoro*.
