IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Mineral Resources and Water Affairs by section 38 of the Precious and Semi-Precious Stones (Protection) Act, the following Regulations are hereby made —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Semi-Precious Stones (Amendment) Regulations, 1988. Citation

2. Regulation 4 of the Semi-Precious Stones Regulations (hereinafter referred to as the 'principal Regulations') is hereby amended by substituting for the words 'Mining Commissioner' which appear therein, the word 'Minister'. Amendment

- "5. A semi-precious stones dealer's licence shall —
- (a) expire on the 31st December, of the year in respect of which it is issued;
 - (b) be valid for such areas as shall be specified in the licence; and
 - (c) be valid for such semi-precious stones as shall be specified in the licence.
