SCHEDULE

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Commerce and Industry by section 5(2) of the Trade and Liquor Act, 1986, the following Regulations are hereby made —

Citation	1. These Regulations may be cited as the Trade and Liquor (Co-opted Members) (Jwaneng) Regulations, 1988.
Persons to be co-opted	2. The persons named in the Schedule hereto are hereby prescribed as persons who may be co-opted to advise the Jwaneng Town Council in the performance of its functions of Local Licensing Authority.
Term prescribed	3. The persons named in the Schedule shall serve as co-opted members for so long as their appointment is not cancelled by the Minister.
