AMENDMENT OF SCHEDULES (NO. 3) NOTICE, 1989
(Published on 27th January, 1989)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Finance and Development Planning by sections 50 and 51 of the Customs and Excise Duty Act, the Schedules to the Act are amended to the extent set out in the Schedule below.

SCHEDULE

Part 4 of Schedule No. 1 to the Act

Notes. By the substitution for Note 9 of the following:

- *9. Any rate of surcharge specified in this Part in respect of any goods shall not apply to any such goods imported in such quantities or of such values as the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Commerce and Industry, may allow by specific permit provided -
- (a) satisfactory evidence is submitted that the goods were irrevocably ordered before 15 August 1988;
 - (b) the continued existence of the undertaking is, in the opinion of the Ministry of Commerce and Industry, in jeopardy; and
 - (c) the application for a permit was in the possession of the Ministry of Commerce and Industry before 30 September 1988.*
