ARRANGEMENT OF BYE-LAWS

BYE-LAW

1. Citation
2. Levy of rates
3. When rates due payable

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Francistown Town Council by regulation 30 as read with regulation 31 of the Town Councils Regulations, and with the approval of the Minister of Local Government and Lands, the following Bye-Laws are hereby made —

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| Citation | 1. These Bye-Laws may be cited as the Francistown Town Council (1989/90) Rating Bye-Laws. |
| Levy of rates | 2. The property rates payable in the Francistown Township for the period 1989/90 shall be at the rate of —
(a) 1,1 thebe in the Pula in respect of all improved rateable land used for residential purposes, and 1,3 thebe in the Pula in respect of all improved rateable land used for commercial or industrial purposes;
(b) 4,4 thebe in the Pula in respect of all unimproved rateable land used for residential purposes, and 5,2 thebe in the Pula in respect of all unimproved rateable land used for commercial or industrial purposes. |
| When rates due payable | 3. The rates fixed in bye-law 2 shall become due and payable by the person liable to pay such rates at the commencement of these Bye-Laws. |
