ARRANGEMENT OF REGULATIONS

REGULATION

1. Citation
2. Amendment to Schedule, Cap 03:06
3. Botswana Police Centenary Medal

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the President of Botswana by section 4 of the Botswana Honours Act, the following Regulations are hereby made —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Botswana Honours (Police Centenary Medal) Regulations, 1990. Citation

2. The Schedule to the Botswana Honours Act is amended by adding at the end thereof the following new medal - Amendment
of Schedule
Cap. 03:06

“11. The Botswana Police Centenary Medal to celebrate the hundredth year since the foundation of what became the Botswana Police Force, and to be awarded to police officers who, on the 15th. August, 1985, were of or above the rank of Assistant Superintendent of Police.”

3. (1) The Botswana Police Centenary Medal shall be struck in sterling silver, circular in shape and encircled by a five-pointed star, the obverse side showing the Coat of Arms of Botswana with the inscription “REPUBLIC OF BOTSWANA”, and the reverse side showing the Botswana Police Badge with the inscription in English “FIRST CENTENARY” and in Setswana “NG-WAGA YA BOLEKGOLO”. (2) The medal shall be worn on the left breast, pendent from a sterling silver clasp affixed to a plain woven Botswana Flag supported on each length by a maroon coloured ribbon 38 millimetres in width.
