**CONTROL OF GOODS (IMPORTS FROM AND EXPORTS TO IRAQ OR
OCCUPIED KUWAIT) REGULATIONS, 1990**
(Published on 29th October, 1990)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Control of Goods, Prices and Other Charges Act, the Minister of Commerce and Industry hereby makes the following Regulations —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Control of Goods (Imports to and Exports from Iraq or Occupied Kuwait) Regulations, 1990. Citation
2. No person shall import any goods from, or export any goods to, Iraq or occupied Kuwait: Prohibition of imports and exports
Provided that the provisions of this regulation shall not apply to any goods exported to Iraq or occupied Kuwait for humanitarian purposes in accordance with any resolution of the United Nations.
3. Any goods being imported into Botswana or exported from Botswana in contravention of regulation 2 may be seized and shall be forfeited to the Government. Forfeiture
