**CONTROL OF GOODS, PRICES AND OTHER CHARGES
(PETROLEUM PRICES) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1990**
(Published on 6th July, 1990)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Control of Goods, Prices and Other Charges Act, the Minister of Commerce and Industry hereby makes the following Regulations —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Control of Goods, Prices and Other Charges (Petroleum Prices) (Amendment) Regulations, 1990, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st July, 1990. Citation
