ROAD TRANSPORT (PERMITS) ACT

ROAD TRANSPORT (PERMITS) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1990
(Published on 2nd February, 1990)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 28 of the Road Transport (Permits) Act, the Minister of Works, Transport and Communications hereby makes the following Regulations —

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| Citation | 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Road Transport (Permits) (Amendment) Regulations, 1990. |
| Amendment of Second and Third Schedules | 2. The Second and Third Schedules to the Road Transport (Permits) Regulations are amended by replacing them with the following new Schedules — |

THIRD SCHEDULE

(Regulation 9)

TOKENS FOR PERMITS

1. In connection with the issue of BA, BS, TA, TS and P permits under the Road Transport (Permits) Act, tokens as described in paragraphs 4 and 5 hereunder shall be issued to the permit holders, one for every vehicle operated under the permit.
2. Tokens shall bear the same serial numbers as their corresponding permits.
3. The token shall be attached to the vehicle so that the inscription is clearly legible to a person standing in front and to the left of the vehicle, and if the vehicle is fitted with a transparent windscreen the token shall be affixed in an upright position on the inside of the windscreen.

4. The colour of the token shall vary with the type of permit as follows —

BA Permit — blue

BS Permit — pink

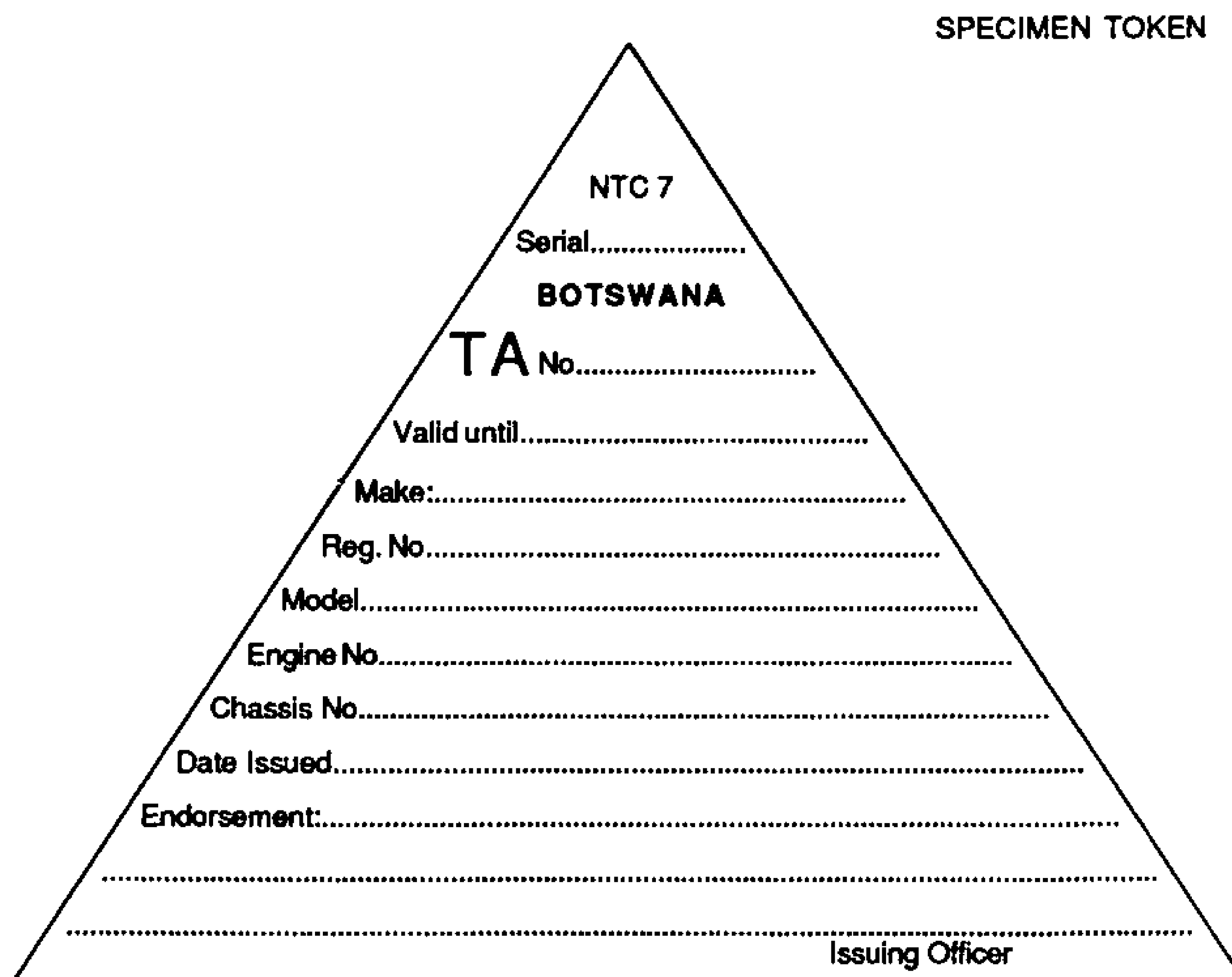
TA Permit — white

TS Permit — yellow

P Permit — green,

and it shall have overprinting thereon, in contrasting colours, indicating the type of permit by the letters BA, BS, TA, TS, or P, as the case may be, and the last two digits of the last year of the validity of the permit.

The token shall be printed on a card in the shape of an isosceles triangle measuring $12,5 \times 12,5 \times 12$ cm, containing the information as indicated in the following diagram —
