(Cap. No. 17:01)**

**STATISTICS (HOTEL OCCUPANCY RETURNS) (AMENDMENT)
REGULATIONS, 1990**
(Published on 13th July, 1990)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Finance and Development Planning by section 15 of the Statistics Act the following Regulations are hereby made —

Citation 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Statistics (Hotel Occupancy Returns) (Amendment) Regulations, 1990.

Amendment
of regulation 2 2. Regulation 2 of the Statistics (Hotel Occupancy Returns) Regulations is amended by substituting for the definition of “hotel” the following definition —

Cap. 17:01 “hotel” means an establishment, which expression shall include a safari
Sub.leg camp, held out by the proprietor thereof as offering sleeping accommodation, whether with or without food or drink, without special contract, to any traveller who presents himself and appears able and willing to pay a reasonable sum for the services and facilities provided;”.

Amendment
of regulation 3 3. Regulation 3 of the Statistics (Hotel Occupancy Returns) Regulations is amended by deleting the word “First” which appears in line 3 thereof.

Replacement
of Schedules 4. The Statistics (Hotel Occupancy Returns) Regulations are amended by deleting the First and Second Schedules thereto and replacing them by the following Schedule —
