ARRANGEMENT OF REGULATIONS

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Education by section 29 of the Education Act, the following Regulations are hereby made —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Teacher Training Colleges (Amendment) Regulations, 1990. Citation
2. Regulation 3 of the Teacher Training Colleges (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Regulations”) is amended by inserting immediately after subregulation (4) thereof the following new subregulation —
“(5) Any application for the re-enrolment at a college or for the re-admission to a hostel, of a student who has ceased to be so enrolled or admitted, as the case may be, shall be made by the student in writing to the principal and shall be subject to such conditions as the Permanent Secretary may direct.” Amendment of regulation 3 of Cap. 58:01 (Sub-Leg)
3. Regulation 4 of the principal Regulations is amended by substituting for subregulation (1) thereof the following subregulation —
“(1) The principal shall consider every application for the enrolment or re-enrolment of a student at a college or for the admission or re-admission of a student to a hostel, as the case may be, and shall, subject to the provisions of these Regulations or any other relevant regulations and to any conditions as may be imposed by the Permanent Secretary, determine whether the student shall be enrolled or re-enrolled or admitted or re-admitted, as the case may be.” Amendment of regulation 4 of principal Regulations
4. Regulation 13 of the principal Regulations is amended in subregulation (3) thereof by substituting for the numerals “200” which appear therein, the numerals “150”. Amendment of regulation 13 of principal Regulations
5. Regulation 16 (1) of the principal Regulations is amended by inserting immediately after paragraph (c) thereof the following new paragraph —
“(d) any student who incites, promotes or participates in any strike, boycott or other act of serious indiscipline prejudicial to the maintenance of a proper standard of conduct in the college.” Amendment of regulation 16 (1) of principal Regulations

6. Regulation 24 of the principal Regulations is amended by inserting immediately after subregulation (2) thereof the following new subregulation —
- “(3) Any student who has not attended classes at the college at which he is enrolled by reason of any strike, boycott or any act of serious indiscipline on two college days in any one calendar year shall cease to be enrolled at such college unless the Permanent Secretary otherwise directs.”
