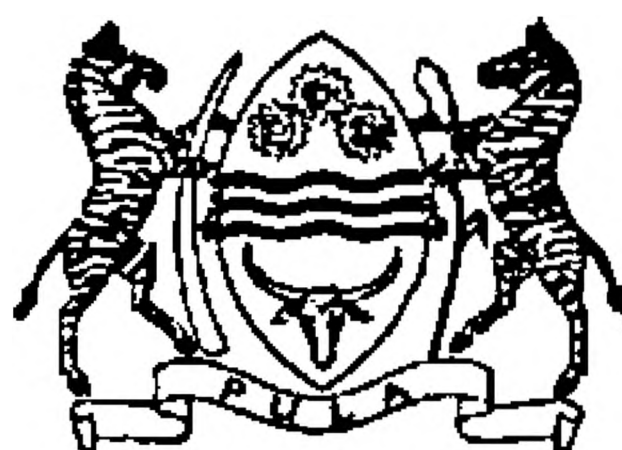

An Act to amend the National Assembly (Salaries and Allowances) Act, 1992.

Date of Assent: 28.12.92

Date of commencement: 31.12.92.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana.

1. This Act may be cited as the National Assembly (Salaries and Allowances) (Amendment) Act, 1992, and shall come into operation on 1st January, 1993.

2. (1) Paragraph 1 (1) of the Schedule to the National Assembly (Salaries and Allowances) Act, 1992 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act") is amended —

- (i) in sub-paragraph (a) by substituting "P98 844" for "P74 748";
- (ii) in sub-paragraph (b) by substituting "P74 136" for "P59 592";

- (iv) in sub-paragraph (d) by substituting "P53 556" for "P41 664";
- (v) in sub-paragraph (e) by substituting for the provisions of that sub-paragraph the following new provisions —

“(e) the Speaker, at the rate of P46 452 per annum for the period beginning from 1st September, 1992 to 31st December, 1992, and at the rate of P63 012 per annum from 1st January, 1993;”

(vi) in sub-paragraph (f) by substituting “P53 556” for “P30 360”;

(vii) in sub-paragraph (g) by substituting “P53 556” for “P30 192”;

(viii) in sub-paragraph (h) by substituting “P40 167” for “P27 312”.

(2) Paragraph 1 (2) of the Schedule to the principal Act is amended by substituting “P43 164” for “P36 888”.

(iv) in sub-paragraph (2) (b) by substituting “P125,48” for “P107,25”.

4. Paragraph 4 of the Schedule to the principal Act is amended —

(i) in sub-paragraph (a) by substituting “P15 288” for “P13 065”;

(iii) in sub-paragraph (c) by substituting “P21 036” for “P17 979”;

(iv) in sub-paragraph (d) by substituting “P23 040” and “P25 776” for “P19 692” and “P22 035” respectively; and

(v) in sub-paragraph (e) by substituting “P29 352” for “P25 092”.

5. Paragraph 7 of the Schedule to the principal Act is amended by substituting for sub-paragraphs (1) and (2) thereof, the following new sub-paragraphs —

“(1) Every member (other than a Minister, the Speaker, an Assistant Minister, the Deputy Speaker, the Leader of the Opposition and the Attorney-General) shall receive an entertainment allowance at the rate of P2 484 per annum.

(2) Every Member, including the Attorney-General, other than a Minister, the Speaker, an Assistant Minister, the Deputy Speaker and the Leader of the Opposition, shall when he is necessarily absent from Botswana attending a conference, seminar or a similar function approved by the President, receive an entertainment allowance of P104,25 together with subsistence allowance at the rates payable to public officers for every day or part thereof.”
