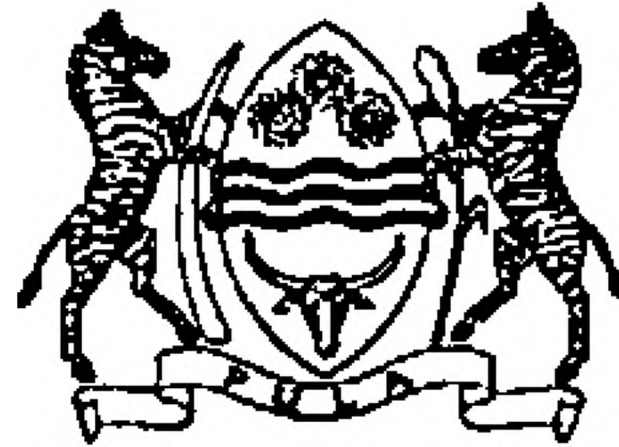


ROAD TRAFFIC (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1992

An Act to amend the Road Traffic Act

Date of Assent: 30th April, 1992.

Date of Commencement: 8th May, 1992.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana

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| 1. This Act may be cited as the Road Traffic (Amendment) Act, 1992. | Short title |
| 2. Section 19 of the Road Traffic Act is amended by deleting subsection (2) thereof. | Amendment of section 19 |
| 3. Section 128 of the Road Traffic Act is amended by adding at the end thereof the following new subsection —
“(3) Notwithstanding the provisions of Part II of this Act, regulations made by the Minister may, where for reasons of security, improvement of control over vehicles and their identification, the high incidence of vehicle thefts, or for any other sufficient reason, he considers such a course to be necessary or desirable, provide that vehicles and trailers previously registered under this Act and allocated registration numbers and registration books, should have such registration cancelled, should be required to be re-registered and should be allocated new registration numbers and new registration books, on such terms as he may specify.”. | Amendment of section 128 |
