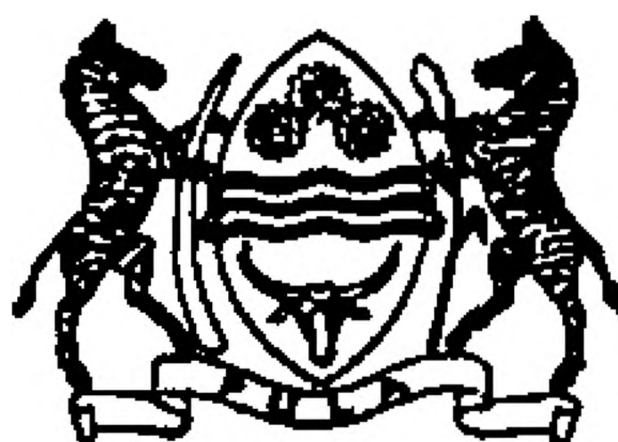

ARRANGEMENT OF SECTIONS

SECTION

1. Short title
2. Consolidated Fund charged with a further sum of P144 442 054.

An Act to make further provision out of the Consolidated Fund to meet expenditure incurred during the year ended 31st March, 1991.

Date of Assent: 2.4.92

Date of Commencement: 3.4.92

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana.

1. This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation (1990/91) Act, 1992. **Short title**

2. The Consolidated Fund is hereby charged with a further sum of P144 442 054 (One Hundred and Forty Four Million Four Hundred and Forty Two Thousand and Fifty Four Pula) to meet expenditure incurred during the financial year which ended on 31st March, 1991, in excess of the amount already appropriated for the services for that year, according to the particulars set forth in the Schedule. **Consolidated Fund charged with a further sum of P144 442 054**
