SCHEDULE

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Control of Goods, Prices, and Other Charges Act, the Minister of Commerce and Industry hereby makes the following Regulations —

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| 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Control of Goods, Prices and Other Charges (Petroleum Prices) Regulations, 1992, and shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st November, 1992. | Citation and commencement |
| 2. In these Regulations "levy" has the same meaning as in the Control of Goods (Petroleum Products)(Levy) Regulations. | Interpretation |
| 3. No person shall sell by retail, either in person or through an agent or employee — | Retail prices of petroleum products |
| (a) at any place specified in the first column of the Schedule hereto, the petroleum products specified at the head of the second, third or fourth column of the said Schedule, at a price exceeding the amount per litre specified in relation to that place in that column, which amount shall include — | |
| (i) in respect of petrol, levies of 1,5 and 6 thebe per litre respectively, payable in respect of the National Petroleum Fund and the Motor Vehicle Insurance Fund, and a levy of 0,5 thebe per litre payable in respect of the Equalisation Fund; | |
| (ii) in respect of diesel, a levy of 0,5 thebe per litre payable in respect of the Equalisation Fund; | |
| (iii) in respect of diesel, levies of 1,3 and 6 thebe per litre respectively, payable in respect of the National Petroleum Fund and the Motor Vehicle Insurance Fund; | |
| (b) at any place specified in the first column of the said Schedule, illuminating paraffin for domestic use, in quantities of a litre or less, at a price proportionate to that specified in relation to that place in the third column of the Schedule; or | |
| (c) at any place not specified in the first column of the said Schedule, the petroleum product at the head of the — | |
| (i) second column of the Schedule at a price exceeding by more than 10 thebe, | |

(ii) third column of the Schedule at a price exceeding by more than 10 thebe,

(iii) fourth column of the Schedule at a price exceeding by more than 10 thebe per litre,

the price at which the product was delivered to him.
