**EMPLOYMENT (DECLARATION OF GOVERNMENT
INDUSTRIAL CLASS WORKERS AS EMPLOYEES)
(REVOCATION) REGULATIONS, 1992**

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 175, as read with section 2 of the Employment Act, the Minister of Labour and Home Affairs hereby makes the following Regulations —

Citation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Employment (Declaration of Government Industrial Class Workers as Employees)(Revocation) Regulations, 1992.

2. (1) The Employment (Declaration of Government Industrial Class Workers as Employees) Regulations are hereby revoked.

(2) Notwithstanding the provisions of subregulation (1), any person who at the date of commencement of these Regulations was a Government industrial class worker, may continue to be employed as such in accordance with the provisions of the Employment Act and as though these Regulations were not enacted, until the termination of his contract or unless or until he elects otherwise.
