**PRESCRIBED CHARGES FOR WATER UTILITIES CORPORATION
SUPPLY AREAS, 1992**
(Published on 11th December, 1992)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 20 of the Waterworks Act, the Water Utilities Corporation has, with the approval of the Minister of Mineral Resources and Water Affairs, and with effect from the 8th. October, 1992, prescribed the following charges in respect of water supplied to the waterworks areas of Gaborone/Lobatse, Jwaneng, Francistown/Sowa and Selibe-Phikwe —

- (a) the minimum charge to be paid by any consumer for water supplied shall be P7 per month;
- (b) a consumer shall pay P30 for a connexion or a reconnexion;
- (c) all consumers shall pay a deposit as follows:

Residential Properties

High cost houses	—	P100
Medium cost houses	—	P 40
Low cost houses	—	P 20

Commercial and Industrial Properties

A minimum of P300, or two months consumption, subject to adjustment based on actual usage, whichever is the greater;

- (d) the charges to be paid by consumers per unit of quantity of water supplied through a meter installed to serve the consumer shall be as follows —
