**SOUTH-EAST DISTRICT (NOISE AND NUISANCE) (AMENDMENT)
BYE-LAWS, 1992**
(Published on 13th November, 1992)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 29 of the Local Government (District Councils) Act, the South-East District Council hereby makes the following Bye-Laws —

1. These Bye-Laws may be cited as the South-East District (Noise and Nuisance) (Amendment) Bye-Laws, 1992. Citation

2. The South-East District (Noise and Nuisance) Bye-Laws are amended by substituting for bye-law 9 thereof the following bye-law — Amendment
of bye-law 9
Cap. 40:01

"Penalties 9. Any person who contravenes any of these Bye-Laws shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable for a first offence to a fine of P100, or in default of payment to imprisonment for 21 days, or for a second or subsequent offence to a fine of P250, or in default of payment to imprisonment for 4 months, and in addition to any other penalty the court convicting the offender may order the confiscation of any instrument, bell, horn, wireless, record player, amplifier or similar device by means of which the offence was committed."
